3.0 ACADEMICS:

3.1 Report cards

The reports for end of term are ready and can be picked from the respective class teachers at the S.4 block. However, reports of students with indiscipline cases shall be picked from the Deputy Administration and those with fees balances from the school bursar after clearing.

3.2 Mocks

S.4 and S.6 candidates shall do both internal and external mocks and the results will be availed to parents as soon as they are ready. However, the different sets of the external mocks to be done will be communicated in subsequent parents' meeting.

3.3 STUDY TRIPS/TOURS:

We did not have any study trips this term. However, we shall have the following trips and request parents to pay for them:

- (a) S.5 Entrepreneurship trip to Ntake factory, Nsangi clays, Harris International Company on 6th/06/2019 at 35,000/=.
- (b) S.6 Entrepreneurship trip to BIDCO, Nyanzi Textile, Kakira sugar works on 11th/06/2019 at 40,000/=

- (c) S.4 Geography field work to Ssezibwa falls, Mabira, Lugazi (SCOUL) and source of the Nile at 40,000/= on 7th/06/2019.
- (d) S.6 Geography field work to Eastern Uganda for 3days from $14^{th}/06/2019$ to $16^{th}/06/2019$ at 180,000/=.
- (e) S.3/S.5 Geography field study to South Western Uganda for five days during holidays at 280,000/=

3.4 WORK BOOKS/PERSONAL TEXT BOOKS:

- (a) We have departmental science work books for Physics, Chemistry and Biology. We have included money for S.3 students on their fees and therefore every student will be entitled to a copy. However, for S.5 Science students, they will be required to pay 25,000/= for each copy (Physics, Biology, Chemistry, ICT)
- (b) We advise parents/guardians to buy personal copies of text books for their students to encourage revision/research.
 - i. S.4 candidates offering **Luganda** will pay **20,000**/= and **40,000**/= for S.6 to cater for seminars, plays and other programs in the department.
 - ii. In addition, S.3 Luganda students will come with personal copies of the following books;
 - Amaggwa n'emitego mu buvubuka by Ruth Kaboggoza.
 - Namulanda by Magoba
 - iii. S.4 candidates are each required to come with a **Math question bank**, Geometry set and Calculator among other things.
 - iv. Students of Fine Art will attend a F/Art exhibition workshop on 20/06/2019 at K.I.U at a fee 15,000/=.

4.0 SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS:

Every student is required to bring the following requirements.

- 8 rolls of toilet paper.
- A water bottle
- A cup and a plate.
- A shopping container.
- A t least 3 white hand kerchiefs.
- A Bible or Quran.
- A dictionary.
- Re-writeable CDs for students doing ICT or pay 5,000/= at school.
- A pair of canvas shoes.
- A knife (only girls of S.1, S.2, S.3 and S.5) /Aprons to use during peeling.

• Fees for candidates include: Payment for external Mocks, resource and extension programs.

- S.3 school fees include money for the practical work books for Chemistry, Physics and Biology.
- Students with outstanding fees balance shall not be received in school on the reporting day.
- Parents who may not have paid full school fees will be required to 75% on reporting.

6.0 FARE WELL PARTY:

The school management has organized a party to bid farewell to our candidates which will take place on **Saturday 18th/05/2019**. Parents should avail to the children some descent clothes suitable for the occasion. No extra fee will be charged to this effect and phones shall not be allowed in school.

7.0 STUDENTS' DISCIPLINE:

Generally, the discipline of students has been good with just a few cases of suspensions and expulsions. We request parents to continue giving guidance to our children.

8.0 HEPATITIS B:

The school organized immunization against Hepatitis last year with **Norvik Hospital** and the process was completed successfully. However, we would like to inform parents with students who are not yet immunized to privately organize it outside school.

9.00 UNIFORM:

Some students have not received part of their uniforms, like the sweaters, trousers for S.4 Students due to some challenges the suppliers had. We therefore apologize for the inconveniences caused but promise to give each student in term II.

10.0 DUBAI EDUCATIONAL TOUR:

The school in partnership with **Exposure tourism** is organizing a study trip to **Dubai** from $6^{th} - 10^{th}$ **December, 2019** at a fee of **US \$ 1,000** per student. This includes 5 days accommodation, meals, all transfers and site entry fees, visa and return Air ticket. Every student will in addition be entitled to a **free tablet.** Parents interested in going with their children will pay **US \$ 1,100**. We have given a copy of the brochure for the details to each students.

11.0 RAMADHAN:

All Muslim students must pay **30,000**/= each cash to the bursar on the reporting day as facilitation for the month of Ramadhan.
