PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS.

1. Admission letter
2. Come with your true parent or guardian.
3. Four (4) recent coloured passport photos.
4. Medium size suitcase (Length: 70–80 cm, Width: 45–55 cm & Height: 25–35 cm).
5. Fifteen (15) black books (**School-branded books available at Shs10,000 each**).
6. Good News Bible or Quran.
7. Dictionary (preferably *Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary*).
8. Mathematical set, enough pens and pencils, and a calculator.
9. Black school shoes.
10. White stockings for girls and black socks for boys.
11. Wristwatch (Smart watches are not allowed).
12. Medium-size black, non-decorated leather belt (for both boys and girls).
13. School bag.
14. Five (5) rolls of toilet paper for personal use.
15. Adequate toothpaste and toothbrush.
16. Fork, spoon, water bottle, plate, cup, and a small shopping container.
17. Bathing soap, washing soap, and shavers.
18. Sanitary towels for girls.
19. An apron.
20. Bucket, slippers, and bathing sponge.
21. Black open shoes for after-class use.
22. Blanket, bed sheets, and towel (All clearly labelled).
23. Mosquito net.
24. Three-pin-plug flat iron.
25. Prayer and hymn book (available at school at Shs30,000).
26. Personal laptops are encouraged.
27. Canvas shoes (must have).

Please note:

I. All clothing to be used at school is provided as part of the fees quoted in this letter. **No additional clothing** apart from what the school provides will be accepted. A school mattress will be issued to each new student upon arrival.

II. The school does **not** provide special diets for students with dietary complications.

III. A-Level girls (S5 & S6) are allowed to maintain decently kept hair in a natural state, provided it does not impose additional maintenance costs on parents.
