these school rules and regulations and seek guidance where a lack of information exists.

These rules and regulations shall be cited as **SMACON Rules and Regulations.** They shall apply to all students enrolled to the school **without exception or discrimination**. Student's continued enrollment in the school is conditional upon satisfactory performance in academics and behavior/discipline demonstrated. Each rule/regulation is supplemented by a set of appropriate guidelines whose application or penalties will be executed at the discretion of the school administration.

A. SCOPE OF APPLICATION

The school rules and regulations apply to areas where the school exists, where school programs extend and to the representation of the school as part of the community in which it exists. The school rules and regulations work in tandem with the staff code of conduct, the Human Resources Manual, Staff job descriptions, Student leaders' roles and responsibilities, and the school examination rules that come into force during examination time. For clarity, students and readers are advised to consult the school management because claims of ignorance of the rules, regulations, and penalties in this document will be treated as guilty as charged.

Students must not wear unauthorized jackets, cardigans, sweaters, etc. Students going out for games and sports, seminars etc. must be in full uniform and carry their identity cards with them for security purposes. Boarders must be fully dressed in weekend/out of class uniform on weekends or after classes. All school wear must be tucked in. Casual wear of any sort is not allowed at College. (All students shall wear House T-Shirts on Wednesdays/sport days. Club T-Shirts can only be worn on Saturdays). 32) THEFT/EXTORTION/MONEY LAUNDERING/FORGERY			
Any student who takes or attempts to take or unknowingly receives stolen school property or student property shall be held liable for the act. B. RESPONSIBILITIES OF A PARENT/GUARDIAN

The College has responsibilities/obligations that parents must fulfill in the proper nurturing of learners to support the teachers:

- 1) Visit the learner on visitation days to check on the academic performance within the following guidelines;
 - a) Provide the learner with the necessary requirements, check on the academic and moral discipline.
 - b) Honour visitation hours (9:00am to 5:00pm), late arrivals shall not be allowed in the school.
 - c) Observe office working hours and days, i.e. 8:00am to 5:00pm from Monday to Saturday.
 - d) Won't be allowed to see students/learners during class time.
 - e) See the school administration before talking to any student. Students found talking to visitors without permission will be sent home with their visitors.
 - f) Not to go to the dormitory areas or spaces, any student found with a visitor in the dormitory will be suspended.
- 2) Collect end-of-term student reports personally, if a person is delegated to collect the report they should have a visitor's card and authorization.
- 3) Attend all class meetings and any other school program as and when may be called to do so.
- 4) Ensure proper student dress code toward plain and neat haircuts, smart/tidy dressing during holidays, and in full school uniform when coming to school.

- 5) Accept to have their child punished when they breach the rules and regulations ("spare the rod and spoil the child").
- 6) Purchase for the students at least two sets of school uniforms, and provide basic educational and personal requirements for the child.
- 7) Encourage students to study seriously while at home during holidays and encourage discipline.
- 8) Pay no-refundable fees promptly and bring the child back to the college for studies on the opening day of the term.
- 9) Not to directly or indirectly breach the school rules and regulations and continuously referring to them in case of doubt.
- 10) Prohibit their sons/daughters from joining wrong and unproductive company.
- 11) Parents/Guardians are expected to dress professionally, smartly, decently, and representatively when visiting their children at school.

C. <u>DEFINATION OF PENALITIES</u>

For purposes of these school rule and regulations, the following clarifications are made:

- ✓ "Day" is defined as any day including Saturdays, Sundays, public holidays and shut-down periods
- ✓ "Offence" means an act in breach of the expectations outlined or implied in the school rules and regulations.
- ✓ "Alleged offence" means Interpretation of breach. Before being confirmed, proved or found out
- ✓ "Offender" Means on who is found to have breached the expectations outlined or implied in the school rules and regulations.
- ✓ "First Offender" A learner/student who commits an offence for the first time.
- ✓ "Repeat Offender" A learner/student who commits the same offence for a second time.
- ✓ "Routine Offender" A learner who commits the same offence more than three times or commits multiple offence simultaneously
- ✓ "Suspension" Sent home for a specified period of time and to return for the final verdict/hearing
- ✓ "Expulsion" Sent away or expelled from the school indefinitely (summary dismissal)
- ✓ "Scope of Application" Out of school, in school, class, play fields, at meal times, examination rooms, study time and all spaces of the school
- ✓ "Reprieve" means cancellation of a punishment
- ✓ "Manual Labour" Physical work given to the learner to engage for a day as a punishment e.g. sweeping; mopping, slashing; garbage collection, cleaning of compound, dormitories, toilets, signages, kitchen; pealing of food, cooking, washing of dishes, digging, etc.
